What are polycrystalline solar panels?

Polycrystalline panels, sometimes referred to as 'multicrystalline panels', are popular among homeowners looking to install solar panels on a budget. Similar to monocrystalline panels, polycrystalline panels are made of silicon solar cells. However, the cooling process is different, which causes multiple crystals to form, as opposed to one.

What are monocrystalline solar panels?

Monocrystalline solar panels are the most popular solar panels used in rooftop solar panel installations today. Monocrystalline silicon solar cells are manufactured using something called the Czochralski method, in which a 'seed' crystal of silicon is placed into a molten vat of pure silicon at a high temperature.

Do polycrystalline solar panels lose efficiency if temperature rises?

Polycrystalline solar panels have a higher temperature coefficient compared to monocrystalline ones. Generally, solar panels based on polycrystalline solar cells have a temperature coefficient in the -0.3% to -1% range. Accordingly, these solar panels tend to lose more of their efficiency temporarily should the temperature rise.

Are polycrystalline solar panels the cheapest option?

Historically, polycrystalline panels have been the cheapest option for homeowners going solar, without majorly sacrificing panel performance. Low prices allowed polycrystalline panels to make up a significant market share in residential solar installations between 2012 and 2016.
