What percentage of Argentina's electricity is generated by wind?

Wind power accounted for 8% of Argentina's total installed power generation capacity and 10% of total power generation in 2023.

What percentage of Argentina's territory is suitable for wind energy utilization?

According to the last report elaborated by the Cara Argentina de Energias Renovables (CADER) on the status of the wind industry in Argentina, 70 % of Argentina's territory is suitable for wind energy utilization with an annual average wind speed of 6 m/s (measured at 50 meter height).

Why is wind power important in Argentina?

Wind power is a clean energy source that does not produce greenhouse gas emissions. By switching from fossil fuels to wind power, Argentina can significantly reduce its carbon emissions, contributing to global efforts to combat climate change. The wind sector saw a large turnaround in September 2011, when the first phase of the 77 MW Rawson Wind Power Plant I & II, the biggest in Argentina at that time, was inaugurated by Emgasud, the owner of the power plant and one of the main local investors in renewable and conventional energy projects in Argentina.
