

Is energy storage a bumpy ride in Asia?

Should South East Asia Invest in solar energy?

But to seize this opportunity, the region will have to ramp up investments in energy storage systems. The US recently imposed tariffs of as high as 3,500 per cent on solar exports from four South-east Asian markets: Cambodia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam. These countries accounted for nearly 80 per cent of US solar imports.

What are Australia's energy storage projects involving solar and wind?

Australia's storage projects have historically focused on standalone BESS, but in recent years, there has been a rise in projects involving solar and wind coupled with BESS that are expected to be commissioned in the next two years.
