

Is Azerbaijan a net energy exporter?

Azerbaijan is a net energy exporter; crude oil and natural gas production and exports are central to Azerbaijan's economy and government revenues. Natural gas accounts for over two-thirds of Azerbaijan's total domestic energy consumption. Oil supplies less than one-third of total energy consumption (Figure 1).¹

How is energy used in Azerbaijan?

Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country.

Does Azerbaijan export electricity?

Azerbaijan has been exporting electricity since 2007. In 2021, it exported around 1.6 TWh to Georgia, Russia and Turkey. Transmission capacity with Russia is around 350 MW.

What is Azerbaijan's energy potential?

According to the Ministry of Energy, the country's technical potential for small hydro is 520 MW, which could generate up to 3.2 TWh annually. Azerbaijan's Renewable Energy Agency under the Ministry of Energy (formerly SAARES) states that the country has up to 800 MW of geothermal energy potential.

How much natural gas does Azerbaijan Export?

Azerbaijan's natural gas exports totaled about 418 Bcf of natural gas in 2019.¹⁴ The country ships most of its natural gas exports from the Caspian through Georgia to Turkey and southern Europe.

Is Azerbaijan a green energy exporter?

SGC became fully operational in January 2021, supplying 6 billion cubic meters of gas per year (bcm) to Turkey, 8 bcm to Italy, and 1 bcm each to Greece and Bulgaria. Azerbaijan is currently pursuing wind and solar projects with the goal of becoming an exporter of green energy to European markets.
