

What is a battery management system (BMS)?

The BMS acts as the specific control component for managing battery temperatures. It includes cooling and heating measures, with temperature thresholds for activating and deactivating devices, additional protective measures, and adjustment times to regulate the battery pack's temperature. Shutdown data storage: When the BMS is powered down, it stores crucial information such as the current SOC and high-level faults. The subordinate BMU, responsible for the individual cell management layer in the BMS, is composed of battery monitoring chips and their associated circuits.

What is a BMU in a battery balancing system?

The main function of the BMU is to collect the voltage and temperature of the battery cell and implement the battery balancing strategy. Information collection communicates with the second level through the communication link, usually using CAN or Daisy chain communication mode. In addition, BMU is also known as the slave control of BMS.
