

# Base station deviation calculation

How should a base station be positioned?

Base stations should use fixed height tripods and be on opposite sides of the project, if possible. Baselines  $\leq 10$  KM (6 miles). Data collected at a 1-second interval for 3 minutes (180 epochs), PDOP  $\leq 2.0$ ,  $\geq 7$  satellites, position solution RMS  $\leq 0.01$  m. No multipath conditions observed.

Is there a standard for a base station antenna?

Why is a base station considered a 'truth'?
