

Who is building a 125 MW solar plant in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

Bosnia and Herzegovina has started working on a 125 MW solar plant - its largest to date. China's Norinco Internationalwill build the facility, with completion expected in one year. The European Commission has published a call for private companies to invest in the Western Balkans.

How much solar energy does Bosnia have?

The average intensity of solar radiation in Bosnia is approximately 1,500 kWh/m2 annually. 12 The national average for kWh per kWp installed in Bosnia annually typically ranges from 1,400 to 1,600 kWh/kWp. 3 According to the data from December 2023,the average price of electricity for households in Bosnia and Herzegovina is \$0.096 per kWh.
