

How many power plants are there in Brunei?

These five power plantsprovide about 58% of the country's electrical needs,mainly serving residential areas. The Brunei National Energy Company (BNEC) is the state-owned utility company that operates and manages the electricity supply network in the country.

What is Brunei electricity order (2017)?

The Electricity Order (2017) is to provide regulation and control of the generation, transmission, distribution, and use of electricity in Brunei. Brunei National Climate Change Policy (BNCCP) Strategy #4 on Renewable Energy - Increase total share of renewable energy to at least 30% of total capacity in the power generation mix by 2035.

How does Brunei produce electricity?

Brunei's power stations primarily produce electricity through natural gas and oil sources, with a small-scale renewable energy project pipeline. The country's electricity sector is overseen by the Department of Electrical Services (DES) and has a total installed capacity of 1,054 MW, serving a small population of approximately 460,000.
