

How does a 5G base station work?

5G base stations operate by using multiple input and multiple output (MIMO) antennasto send and receive more data simultaneously compared to previous generations of mobile networks. They are designed to handle the increased data traffic and provide higher speeds by operating in higher frequency bands, such as the millimeter-wave spectrum.

Why is 5G better than 4G?

Because 5G operates at higher frequencies, it requires a much denser network of base stations. In urban environments, this means installing 10 times more base stations per square kilometer compared to 4G. This presents both opportunities and challenges. On one hand, denser networks lead to better speeds and connectivity.
