



# Can the 12V power supply of the chassis be equipped with an inverter

How much current does a 2000W 12V inverter use?

2000W from 12V equates to 167A. Depending on the design of your inverter, if the supply voltage drops a little, the input current may increase yet further. There will inevitably be some voltage drop in the wiring but you should aim to keep it as small as possible.

Can a vehicle chassis be used for 12V ground?

As far as using the vehicle chassis for 12V ground, it "can" be less reliable. I used thick #00 pure copper welding cable with hydraulically crimped ring terminals for both 12V Positive and Negative connections - fairly short at only 3' long (with a 250Amp fuse)...
