



Communication construction base station design standards

Do standards and guidelines apply to new communication sites?

The standards and guidelines in this manual apply to new communication sites built after the publication date of this revision. They are not required for sites built prior to publication of this revision.

What types of communications equipment systems are used in high-rise buildings?

High-rise buildings often utilize communications equipment systems such as detectors and alarms that transmit to centralized control centers within the system itself and can be included as part of a central alarm system connected to the local fire department. Some buildings may have a dedicated facility alarm (3.12.6.1 AUTOMATIC FIRE DETECTION).

What standards are used to determine if a communications facility is unexposed?

The following standards can be used by the engineer to help determine if the communications facility is unexposed: BS 6651:1999, IEC 61024-1-2, NFPA 780-2004, or other applicable standard in effect and recognized by the local authority having jurisdiction. (4.3 COMMON GROUNDING (EARTHING))

What are the general requirements for tower construction?

Communication tower construction shall be performed in accordance with the current edition of ANSI/EIA/TIA-222 (or other applicable local Standards body design requirements) or more stringent standard per jurisdiction. General requirements for tower construction include: All personnel climbing a tower shall be tied off at all times.

What are the UCF CS&T telecom design guidelines?
