

How much does electricity cost in Timor-Leste?

The flat rates vary from \$3 per month for low-income consumers with a two-amp connection and 6-hour daily provision of power, to \$25 per month for connection above four amps and 24-hour access to power. Is the current electricity tariff structure suitable for Timor-Leste?

The current electricity tariff level and structure is considered to be reasonably appropriate to the current situation in Timor-Leste. However,in the longer run it is recommended that a cost-based tariff structure,including indexation of tariffs to fuel prices, will be implemented.

How many households in Timor-Leste have access to electricity?

As noted earlier, only 20% of households in Timor-Leste have access to electricity. The Government intends to address this situation in the decade ahead with a sustained program of rural electrification.

What are the funding requirements for rural electrification in East Timor?

Most of the remaining funding requirement would be for the start up of the proposed rural electrification program and related studies. TFET = Trust Fund for East Timor, EDTL = Electricidade de Timor Lorosae, CFET = Consolidated Funds for East Timor.

How much does EDTL cost in Timor-Leste?

EDTL's operating cost is estimated at \$0.42/kWh,but tariffs in Timor-Leste are well below this. Residential tariffs are structured as increasing blocks,with a tariff of \$0.05/kWh for the first 20 kWh of consumption and \$0.12/kWh for consumption above 20 kWh. As a result,all residential consumers receive the subsidy,regardless of income. 10.
