

How are EMS system costs determined?

What are EMS costs?

According to the Institutes of Medicine,"EMS costs include the direct costs of each emergency response, as well as the readiness costs associated with maintaining the capability to respond quickly,24-hours a day,7-days a week."

Does the EMS system pay for ambulance services?

The EMS system, especially the ambulance service function, relies heavily on reimbursements from third party payers and currently ambulance services must provide patient transportation in order to be reimbursed for services.

Why do EMS agencies have a different service delivery model?

Due to the unique nature of the service delivery model, EMS agencies provide an increasing number of responses where no reimbursement is available. For example, EMS is called to an emergency scene by law enforcement to assess a patient at a motor vehicle accident at significant cost.

Are EMS costs accounted for in reimbursement models?

These costs are inherent in the delivery of service and must be adequately accounted forin the reimbursement models. EMS response is reported to be at the intersection of healthcare, public health, and public safety, yet reimbursement by health insurance providers is often the only source of funding.

How do EMS metrics help explain service delivery costs?

Each of these metrics,tracked over time,can be very useful in explaining service delivery costs to stakeholders. EMS systems are essentially funded from two buckets: Fee for service (FFS) revenue and tax subsidies.
