

What telecommunications are available in the Gambia?

Telecommunications in the Gambia includes radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. Radio: The state-owned Gambia Radio and Television Service has two AM stations (Bonto, Basse) and three FM stations (Bonto, Serrekunda, Banjul). There are also seven private FM stations in Serrekunda, Banjul, and Basse.

How many radio stations are there in the Gambia?

Today, there are fivemore radio stations in the Gambia. Main lines: 64,200 lines in use,159th in the world (2012). Mobile cellular: 1.5 million lines,151st in the world (2012). Teledensity: ~80 per 100 persons, combined fixed-line and mobile-cellular (2011).

What happened to the Internet in the Gambia?

Since 30 November 2016, the evening before the presidential election, internet access, mobile communication and phone calls have been completely shut downby all providers, as ordered by the president of The Gambia. What is the telecom market composition in Gambia?

Gambia's telecom market is dominated by the state-owned Gamtel, which retains a monopoly on fixed-line telephony services. Four mobile networksprovide effective competition. The market's leader is Africell (owned by American), with about 65% market share.
