

#### Where is 5G available in NZ?

In NZ 5G has already been launched by Spark and Vodafone in limited locations, with further rollout planned in the near future. Spark initially trialled 5G wireless in Alexandra, and then extended 5G to parts of Westport, Twizel, Tekapo, Hokitika and Clyde.

#### Where is 5G & 4G coverage available?

#### Will NZ use 4G as a 'control layer' for 5G?

NZ's existing 4G system is planned to be used as a "control layer" for 5G. (Frequencies used in 4G systems vary from 700MHz (Vodafone rural and Spark\*) to 700,900 and 1800 MHz (2 Degrees). Spark also uses 1800 MHz for 4G. The plan to use of 4G systems as a "control layer" for 5G means that the number of cell sites in urban areas could be doubled.

#### What is 5G in Aotearoa New Zealand?

What is 5G? 5G stands for 5th generation. It's the latest cellular network after 2G,3G,and 4G. The 5G network is more technologically advanced and implementation has begun throughout the world and here in Aotearoa New Zealand. All cellular networks use radio waves to transmit data.

#### What frequencies will 5G use in NZ?

The initial roll out of 5G in NZ will use frequencies in the same range as 4G. In the future, the network will use a higher frequency (lower wavelength waves) - known as millimetre waves. These are closer in frequency to those used for satellite communications and some vehicle radars.

#### Does New Zealand have a 4G network?

As an island nation, providing offshore mobile coverage is essential. Our 4G network covers a significant part of New Zealand's coastal waters, but the real game-changer is One NZ Satellite, which offers TXT coverage up to 85 nautical miles off the coast!


