

Who is responsible for the electricity sector in East Timor-Leste?

Since 2002, the Government of Timor-Leste has been responsible for the administration of the electricity sector in East Timor-Leste. Responsibility was transferred from the East Timor Transitional Administration (ETTA) in August 2001. Four main laws have shaped the development of the electricity sector since 1999.

Does East Timor have electricity?

The electricity supply network in East Timor is in a state of flux. The government is currently in the process of implementing a nationwide electrification plan, which aims to increase access to grid electricity from its current level of around 30% to 100% by 2030.

How much does electricity cost in Timor-Leste?

The flat rates vary from \$3 per month for low-income consumers with a two-amp connection and 6-hour daily provision of power, to \$25 per month for connection above four amps and 24-hour access to power. How much electricity will Timor-Leste require?

According to Table 3, Timor-Leste will need to plan for 50-100 MW of additional generation capacity over the next two decades, depending on the growth in demand and the pace of electrification.

Is nuclear power feasible in Timor-Leste?
