What does WH mean in a battery?

It indicates how much current a battery can deliver over a specific period. o Wh (Watt-Hour): Measures energy capacity. It represents the total energy a battery can supply. o Relationship: $Wh = Ah \times Voltage (V)$. This formula connects the charge capacity to the energy capacity, factoring in the voltage.

We can use the Kilowatt-hour (kWh) capacity of a battery to determine how long it can supply a device with electricity through a transformer. A transformer steps-up or steps-down the voltage being supplied to a device, in order to match the device's voltage with the rest of the circuit.
