

Estonia Energy Storage Project

Where is Estonia's largest battery storage facility located?

The flagship battery storage project commenced operations on February 1, only days before cutting ties with the Russian power grid. Estonian state-owned energy company Eesti Energia has inaugurated the nation's largest battery energy storage facility at the Auvere industrial complex in Ida-Viru County.

How will a battery energy storage park work in Estonia?

The battery energy storage park and its substation will be connected to the electricity transmission network using a 330kV AC underground cable, marking a first in Estonia. Baltic Storage Platform confirmed that the BESS will seek to ensure the stability and resilience of the Estonian electricity grid.

Why is energy storage important for Estonia?

Energy storage is also critical for the ability of Estonia to achieve zero-emission levels for electricity generation by 2030.

How has Lithuania made a decisive move toward energy security for Estonia?

Lithuania has made a decisive move toward energy security for Estonia with the beginning of construction of what will be the biggest battery park in the European mainland.

Will Estonia & Latvia re-integrate their electricity networks with Europe by 2025?

Eesti Energia was unable to secure a contract for a large-scale energy storage facility through an international tender. It is expected that it would have a capacity ranging from 25 to 50 megawatt-hours that sufficiently meets the reserve needs of the Baltic countries.
