

Does Ethiopia have a coal plant?

Ethiopia has never had an operational coal plant, although it does operate a few small coal mines with a relatively small output. Most of the country's electricity is generated through hydropower, with a small share generated by wind and bioenergy.

What is the energy potential of Ethiopia?

Nowadays Ethiopia total installed capacity of electric generation is about 4.5 GW (2019) mainly generated by hydro (90%) and followed by wind energy (7.6%) . Table 1 shows country exploitable energy potential and currently exploited amount.

How does Ethiopia generate electricity?

Most of the country's electricity is generated through hydropower, with a small share generated by wind and bioenergy. The Yayu power station is a 90 megawatt (MW) coal plant that was proposed in 2011 but has seen no apparent progress since 2019. Ethiopia is a member of the Powering Past Coal Alliance.

What is the average energy access in Ethiopia?

The average energy access,in most of the countries in this region,is below 20%. Ethiopia is one of the countries in sub Saharan Africa and endowed with numerous rivers,lakes and ample water resources which,constitutes 20% of the total technically feasible potential in Africa.

Why is Ethiopia investing in solar and wind energy?

To mitigate this, Ethiopia is investing in solar and wind energy. The country possesses some of Africa's most promising renewable resources--a 108 km² solar park alone could meet the current annual electricity demand of 18 TWh. Yet, these resources remain significantly underutilized.

To avoid overreliance on a single source,the government must fast-track grid integration and enhances private sector participation through Independent Power Producer (IPP) schemes.
