What happens when you exceed the max current of the power supply depends on the power supply. It may blow a fuse or it may lower the voltage, and therefore the speed of the motor until its current is sufficient to drive the motor at a lower speed. If that speed is zero RPM or a stalled motor, the motor will heat up and you could destroy the motor.
