

How high should an outdoor electrical outlet be?

The required height an outdoor electrical outlet must be is a maximum of six feet and six inchesabove the ground. There is no minimum height required. It is also required to have all ground-fault circuit-interrupters (GFCI) protected for all outdoor receptacles. There must be a receptacle required for decks, porches, and patios.
