

# How long does it take for Bangladesh's energy storage power to be exported

What kind of energy does Bangladesh use?

Bangladesh's power generation is based on fossil fuels, with natural gas contributing 65% of power generation and a quarter of the generation coming from liquid fuel, while the rest comes from hydropower, coal, imported power, and renewables; more recently, LNG has been introduced into the energy mix.

Can energy storage be used in Bangladesh?

Concluded in May 2023, the assignment assessed available energy storage technologies, evaluated the role of energy storage in the current grid conditions, identified potential storage locations, analysed energy storage requirements under variable renewable energy (VRE) integration, and developed a roadmap for energy storage in Bangladesh.

What percentage of Bangladesh's power is based on gas?

Bangladesh's power sector relies heavily on gas. Currently, approximately 39% of the installed power capacity is gas-based, 18% is coal-based, 23% is liquid fuel-based, 3% is imported, 4% is renewable energy, and 9% is captive power.

What role do US companies play in Bangladesh's energy industry?

U.S. companies play an outsized role in the power and energy industry in Bangladesh. U.S. companies supply around 55 percent of Bangladesh's domestic natural gas production and are among the largest investors in power projects. U.S.-origin power turbines currently provide 80 percent of Bangladesh's installed gas-fired power generation capacity.

What's in the Bangladesh Power Sector Roadmap?

The roadmap highlights specific use-cases for consideration in the Bangladesh power sector over three different future time horizons. It also includes a summary of indicative policy and regulation actions and interventions that may be considered to enable the deployment of energy storage within the defined time horizons.

How has Bangladesh's power sector changed over the past decade?

In the past decade, Bangladesh's power sector registered significant developments, with the generation capacity increasing from 7,264 MW in 2010-2011 to 23,482 MW in FY 2022-2023.
