What is battery charging time?

Battery charging time is the amount of time it takes to fully charge a battery from its current charge level to 100%. This depends on several factors such as the battery's capacity, the charger's voltage output, and the battery charge level. The basic formula used in our calculator is: $\text{Charging Time} = \frac{\text{Battery Capacity (Ah)}}{\text{Charger Current (A)}}$

How to calculate battery charge time?

How to calculate battery charging time based on depth of discharge (DOD)?

To calculate the battery charging time based on Depth of Discharge (DoD), you need to multiply the battery capacity by the DoD and the charge current by the charge efficiency. Divide both the answers to get the battery charging time. Formula: $\text{Charge Time} = \frac{(\text{Battery Capacity} \times \text{Depth of Discharge})}{(\text{Charge Current} \times \text{Charge Efficiency})}$.
