



# How many components can a micro inverter string together

How many microinverters do I Need?

Unlike string inverters, where you only need one or two for your entire system, you usually need the same number of microinverters as you have solar panels since each panel needs its own inverter. That said, there are certain microinverters that can connect to two to four panels.

How many microinverters can I put in a string branch?

The maximum number of microinverters you can put in a string branch depends on the voltage ratings of the panels on that branch and the model of your microinverters. The below table gives you the number of microinverters you can put in one string branch for each of these combinations.

Do you need a string inverter or a microinverter?

Microinverters are expendable so if you wanted to add additional panels in the future even if they don't match the characteristics of the panels you have, you can just add another inverter and can expand your system as much as you want whereas, with string inverters, you do need to keep some types of panels.

How many string inverters does a solar system have?

An entire solar system is usually managed by only one or two string inverters. Each "series string" usually consists of six to 12 individual solar panels wired together. The end of this chain is then connected to the string inverter.

What is a microinverter & how does it work?

**Limited Flexibility:** The design limits the system's flexibility for panel orientation or placement, especially in areas with shading issues. Microinverters are compact inverters installed on the back of each solar panel in a PV system. Unlike string inverters, microinverters work independently for each panel.

What is a string inverter?

A string inverter is a type of central inverter that receives solar panel inputs in strings (or groups) and converts their currents from DC to AC. An entire solar system is usually managed by only one or two string inverters. Each "series string" usually consists of six to 12 individual solar panels wired together.
