How many solar panels do you need to power a house?

The goal for any solar project should be 100% electricity offset and maximum savings -- not necessarily to cram as many panels on a roof as possible. So, the number of panels you need to power a house varies based on three main factors: In this article, we'll show you how to manually calculate how many panels you'll need to power your home.

How many kW solar panels do I Need?

As we calculated earlier, the California household needs a 7.2 kW system to cover its electricity needs. A comparable household in Massachusetts needs a 9.9 kW system. So, in less sunny areas like Massachusetts, you might consider choosing highly efficient solar panels to maximize your energy output per square foot.

How many solar panels are in a solar system?

Plugging our numbers in from above, we get: Number of panels = $10,791 \text{ kWh} / 1.1$ or $1.7 / 450 \text{ W}$...which gives us between 15 and 22 panels in a solar panel system, depending on which production ratio we use (15 for a 1.7 ratio and 22 for a 1.1 ratio).

How do I calculate how many solar panels I Need?

You can calculate how many solar panels you need by dividing your yearly electricity usage by your area's production ratio and then dividing that number by the power output of your solar panels. To put it simply: Number of panels = annual electricity usage / production ratio / panel wattage

How much power does a solar panel use?

Solar panel power ratings range from 250W to 450W. Based on solar.com sales data, 400W is the most popular power rating and provides a great balance of output and Price Per Watt (PPW). If you have limited roof space, you may consider a higher power rating to use fewer panels. If you want to spend less per panel, you may consider a lower wattage.

How big should a solar panel be?

The table above assumes solar panel dimensions of 5.5 feet by 3 feet. If your home is small or has an unusually shaped roof, the power output and efficiency of your solar panels are especially important to consider. With a large roof, you can probably choose less efficient solar panels because you have more space for more panels.
