How much energy does a solar panel produce?

A solar panel's wattage has the biggest impact on how much energy it produces. An average 400-watt monocrystalline solar panel will produce 2 kWh of energy per day. Solar panels with higher efficiency ratings will generally have higher wattages and are best for homes with limited roof space.

How many solar panels do you need to go off-grid?

Off-grid solar systems are not connected to the grid at all, so it's even more important that your solar and battery systems are properly sized. How much space do solar panels take up?

A typical 7.6 kW solar installation covers about 334 square feet, about 20% of the space of an average residential roof. If you have space constraints, consider high-efficiency panels that can produce more electricity in less space.
