What is the standard voltage in South Africa?

In South Africa, the standard voltage is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. In the 1930s, South Africa, as a former British colony, adopted the plug system that was standard in the UK at the time. It was originally defined in BS 317 (published in 1928) and BS 546 (published in 1934).

What type of power outlet does South Africa use?

In South Africa, they use power outlets and plugs of type C, type M and type N. The voltage is 230 V, and the frequency is 50 Hz. You will need an adapter for type C, M and N power outlets in South Africa. You will need a voltage converter as well. Be cautious with some devices due to the frequency difference.

What type of power plugs & sockets are in South Africa?

In South Africa the power plugs and sockets are of type D, M and N. The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz. Which power plugs and sockets in South Africa?

What type of electricity does South Africa use?

In South Africa, the standard electricity supply is 220/230V, and the plugs used are type M, which are large 15-amp plugs. To avoid any inconvenience, it's recommended that you bring your own travel adapter when visiting South Africa, as your home country's plug type might not fit into local outlets.

Do I need a voltage converter in South Africa?

The voltage used in South Africa is 230V and the frequency is 50Hz. If this is the same in your own country, you don't need a voltage converter when travelling to South Africa. If the voltage and/or frequency in your country is different, you should check if your devices are dual voltage.

Can I use a 230 volt appliance in South Africa?
