

# How many watts can a battery inverter drive

How much power does a 2000 watt inverter take?

If you max out the inverter at 2000 watts, you are pulling  $2000 \text{ watts} / 12 \text{ volts} = 166.6 \text{ DC amps}$  per hour. If you use a 200-amp 12-volt battery, you would divide the 200-amp battery  $/ 166.6 \text{ amps} = 1.2 \text{ hours}$  of run time. This is if you plan on fully depleting the battery, which we DON'T recommend. We recommend 50% depth of discharge.

How much power does a 12V inverter use?

For example: If you're running a 1500W inverter on your 12v battery with 1000 watts of total AC load. So your inverter will be consuming 83 amps ( $\text{amps} = \text{watts} / \text{battery volts}$ ) from the battery for which you'll need a very thick cable. Using a thin cable in this scenario can damage the inverter or you'll not be able to run your load.

How many batteries to run a 1000W inverter?

Now we need to divide the available energy with the used energy:  $864\text{Wh} / 50\text{W} = 17 \text{ hours}$  or run time. If you increase the battery capacity you can run the fridge for longer. Conclusion You need one 12V 100Ah battery or four 12V 100Ah lead-acid batteries in parallel to run a 1,000W inverter.

How many amps in a 48 volt inverter?

Now, maximum amp draw (in amps) =  $(1500 \text{ Watts} \div \text{Inverter's Efficiency (\%)}) \div \text{Lowest Battery Voltage (in Volts)}$  =  $(1500 \text{ watts} / 95\%) / 20 \text{ V} = 78.9 \text{ amps}$ . B. 100% Efficiency In this case, we will consider a 48 V battery bank, and the lowest battery voltage before cut-off is 40 volts. The maximum current is,  $= (1500 \text{ watts} / 100\%) / 40 = 37.5 \text{ amps}$

How much current does an inverter draw from a battery?

The inverter will draw a current of 83A from the battery. If we repeat the same calculations for a 24V and 48V battery system:  $1,000\text{W} / 24\text{V} = 41\text{A}$   $1,000\text{W} / 48\text{V} = 20\text{A}$  We can see that the current will decrease if we increase the battery voltage. We will use the current draw in step 3. Step 2. Determine C-rate Next, we need to consider the battery C-rate.

How many amps do inverters draw?

Inverters with a greater DC-to-AC conversion efficiency (90-95%) draw fewer amps, whereas inverters with a lower efficiency (70-80%) draw more current.
