

How many watts a day can a solar panel power?

PTotal= $(4 \times 15 \text{W}) + 60 \text{W} = 120 \text{ Watts}$. This is our daily load per hour in watts we need to power up by solar panels. We Need it for 4 Hrs Daily Now,we need a continuous power supply for 4 hours a day by solar panel to the load. Therefore,multiply 120 Watts with 4 hours. PDaily = 120 W x 4 Hrs = 480 WattHours per day. Sunshine = 6 Hrs

What does wattage mean on a solar panel?
