How many kW is a 20 watt solar panel?

Usually, it is 1.2 to 1.5 which is multiplied by the desired output. For example with a 20% buffer, the required solar panel output with Buffer (Watts) =  $6 \text{ kW} \times 1.20 = 7.2 \text{ kW}$ .
