

How many watts of solar panels are suitable for South Sudan

Does solar energy have potential in Sudan?

According to the study, solar energy has a huge potential in Sudan for contributing to the energy sector and development of the country. However, this potential is being challenged by the country's lack of incentives and current policies.

How much solar radiation does Sudan have?

Sudan possesses an average annual radiation range of 436 to 639 W/m² per year, which exceeds the annual global average. The period of solar radiation in the country is between 8.5 and 11 hours per day. There is, furthermore, much unused land available for RE development.

Are solar power generators a problem in Sudan?

An economic comparison between three types of electricity generators; stand-alone PV modules (50 Wp), two imported gen-sets (0.5, 2.4 kW), and a small mini-grid system (313 kW peak) proved challenging in adopting PV systems in Sudan (Dongola and Northern Kurdufan).

How many Watts Does a solar panel produce per square foot?

Dividing the specified wattage by the square footage of the solar panel will give us just this result: The average solar panel output per area is 17.25 watts per square foot. Let's say that you have 500 square feet of roof available for solar panel installation.

A typical 300-watt solar panel is 65.8 inches long and 36.1 inches wide. It takes up 16.5 sq ft of area. If you have a 1000 sq ft roof, and you can use 75% of that roof area for solar panels, you can theoretically put 45 300-watt solar panels on a 1000 sq ft roof.
