

How much output current should the base station power supply be changed to

How can the electronic industry reduce power requirements for base stations?

As a result, the electronic industry is exploring new methods to reduce the power requirements for the electronic equipment used in the base stations. The first approach is to make the base stations more tolerant to heat which will then require less power for air conditioning.

How much power does a cellular base station use?

This problem exists particularly among the mobile telephony towers in rural areas, that lack quality grid power supply. A cellular base station can use anywhere from 1 to 5 kW power per hour depending upon the number of transceivers attached to the base station, the age of cell towers, and energy needed for air conditioning.

How much power does a PSU need?

This is when the PSU is no longer powering the PA, which is the main power draw, but still needs to power other electronics. The current target for low-load efficiency is about 30 W. Some OEMs would like to see that drop to nearly 10 W.

How much power does a PSU need during a quiescent period?

During quiescent periods--typically 5 ms to 100 ms--the PSU must minimize all load power with the basic functions of the antenna unit remaining active. It also must be able to ramp up to full power whenever the antenna wants to check for any active users within its range.

What is the maximum output power requirement for BS?

There is no general maximum output power requirement for BSs. As mentioned in the discussion of BS classes in the preceding section, there is, however, a maximum output power limit of 38 dBm for medium range BSs, 24 dBm for local area BSs, and of 20 dBm for home BSs.

Why do cellular base stations need maintenance?

Cellular base stations use power without any interruption and also need maintenance. The increase in demand of power base stations from the Indian telecommunication industry is a big challenge, especially in rural India.
