



# How much voltage can the inverter get

How much power does an inverter need?

It's important to note what this means: In order for an inverter to put out the rated amount of power, it will need to have a power input that exceeds the output. For example, an inverter with a rated output power of 5,000 W and a peak efficiency of 95% requires an input power of 5,263 W to operate at full power.

Using the CEC efficiency, the input power to the inverter must be  $P_{IN} = P_{OUT} / \text{CEC Efficiency}$ .  $3,300 \text{ W} / 0.945 = 3,492 \text{ W}$ .
