

How to Calculate the Power of a Battery

How do you calculate power capacity of a battery?

Power capacity is how much energy is stored in the battery. This power is often expressed in Watt-hours (the symbol Wh). A Watt-hour is the voltage (V) that the battery provides multiplied by how much current (Amps) the battery can provide for some amount of time (generally in hours). $\text{Voltage} \times \text{Amps} \times \text{hours} = \text{Wh}$.

How do you calculate energy in a battery?

Energy (E): The total amount of energy stored in the battery, typically measured in watt-hours (Wh) or kilowatt-hours (kWh). To calculate the energy stored in a battery, use the following formula: $E = V \times C$ Where E is the energy stored, V is the battery's voltage, and C is the battery's capacity.

How do you measure a battery capacity?
