Is solar power a cost-effective energy source in India?

The Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) has facilitated growth by organising solar power auctions, leading to competitive tariff rates that make solar power one of India's most cost-effective energy sources. In some auctions, solar tariffs have fallen below Rs. 2.50 (US\$0.030) per kWh, often cheaper than conventional coal-fired power.

How much does a solar energy storage system cost in India?

Even the recently approved power tariff for new RE plus storage plants, tendered by the Solar Energy Corporation of India, had the winning bids for co-located solar and Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) ranging from 6.15 to 6.85 Rs/kWh for peak power supply and 2.88 Rs/kWh for off-peak supply.

What is India's solar power capacity?

India's solar power installed capacity was 119.02 GW AC as of 31 July 2025. The use of solar power is also necessary for India to achieve carbon neutrality by 2070, by achieving 500 GW of renewable energy by 2030, of which at least around 250 GW will be generated by solar power.
