

# Indonesia's telecom operator base stations

What is the telecommunications market in Indonesia?

Indonesia's telecommunications market is one of the largest in the world, with over 355 million mobile cellular subscriptions as of 2024, making it the third-largest cellular market globally, behind India and China. The market is dominated by four major Mobile Network Operators (MNOs): Telkomsel, Indosat Ooredoo Hutchison, XL Axiata, and Smartfren.

How many cellular operators are there in Indonesia?

In Indonesia, there are six cellular operators registered with the Ministry of Communication and Informatics (Kominfo), namely Telkomsel, Indosat Ooredoo, XL Axiata, Hutchison 3 (Tri) Indonesia, Smartfren, and Sampoerna. Each operator has the right to use the radio frequency spectrum to roll out cellular network services.
