What are cell towers & base stations?

Cell towers or base stations serve the same purpose that is to produce network signals for the consumers. The cells move from one tower to another depending on the coverage area or frequency. The user of the carrier receives the signals or cells from the cell towers that are generated by the base station.

A cell site, cell phone tower, cell base tower, or cellular base station is a cellular-enabled mobile device site where antennas and electronic communications equipment are placed (typically on a radio mast, tower, or other raised structure) to create a cell, or adjacent cells, in a cellular network.
