

Do I need a power adapter in Cameroon?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cameroon, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer.

What type of plug does Cameroon use?

Cameroon uses power outlets and plugs of types C &E. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Do the outlets look different in your country? You'll need a power plug adapter. Type C - The standard European plug. Commonly used in Europe, South-America and Asia, but also in quite a few other countries.

Do Europeans need a travel adapter in Cameroon?

Europeans do not need a travel adapteror transformer when traveling to Cameroon. Most device plugs will work with the outlet types in Cameroon. Also, the voltage in Cameroon is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Cameroon Use? Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin.

Which plugs fit in a Type E outlet in Cameroon?

Plug types C and Falso fit in a type E outlet. If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in Cameroon, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter. All power sockets in Cameroon provide a standard voltage of 220V with a standard frequency of 50Hz.

What voltage does Cameroon use?

Also, the voltage in Cameroon is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Cameroon Use? Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 220-240V. This outlet is rated for 2.5 amps.
