An inverter converts direct current (DC) power, like from a car battery or solar panels, into alternating current (AC) power that can be used to run standard electrical devices. Inverters come in different sizes and wattage capacities to handle varying power loads.

Does an inverter need a lot of power?

Yes, but the amount drained depends on the inverter size and design. The more modern the inverter, the more power you save. A 90% efficient inverter means it requires 10% more power than what its load requires. If you run a 300 watt load for instance, the inverter will need 330 watts.
