

What type of energy is used in Kenya?

Kenya's electricity is mainly generated from renewable energy, which made up 88% of installed power capacity in 2021. Supply is led by geothermal energy (41%), followed by large hydropower (30%) and wind energy (16%).

How many people in Kenya have electricity access in 2021?

This increase resulted in 23 million peoplewith rural electricity access in 2021 contributed by the regulatory and policy frameworks for off-grid, and mechanisms such as Pay-As-You-Go IRENA'S 2023. Projects like KOSAP and PAOP fuel Kenya's remarkable progress in energy access.

What is Kenya's electricity access rate?

Universal access to electricity Kenya's electricity access rate rose from 19.2% in 2010 to over 75% in 2021 (World Bank,2022a). However,a significant part of the rural population still lacks electricity access. One reason for this is limited grid coverage.

Does Kenya have electricity?

Kenya predominantly generates electricity from renewable resources. Since 2013, access to electricity in Kenya has increased significantly. In 2022, Kenya managed to provide electricity to the majority share of its population, at almost 22 percent more than the overall electricity access gained in the Sub-Saharan African region.
