The country imports about 80% of its power requirements from South Africa (64.5%) and 16.1% from the Southern Africa Power Pool (SAPP).

How many megawatts are there in India?

Total installed generation capacity is 69.6 megawatts, of which 60.1 mega watts is from hydropower, which contributes to 16.4% to the total country's energy consumption while local Independent Power Producers (IPPs) contribute 4.75%. Average electricity demand increased to 236 megawatts in 2018 from 221 mega watts in 2014.

Swaziland's power is supplied and distributed by the Swaziland Electricity Company (SEC) which was established by the Swaziland Electricity Company Act (2007).
