

Can solar PV be used in Libya?

The potential and opportunities for solar PV in Libya have been assessed. Future prospective of exploiting solar PV has been drawn in Libya. The solar photovoltaic (PV) is one way of utilising incident solar radiation to produce electricity without carbon dioxide (CO₂) emission.

Who is building a solar power plant in Libya?

The construction of a solar photovoltaic power plant is already underway in Kufra, with a planned capacity of 100 MWp.

Will Libya build a 62 kWp solar power plant?

Upon completion, the project will be connected to the national grid and will service the wider north-western region, with a view to reducing the country's current power generation deficit of 1,500 MW.

A study performed by (Aldali and Ahwide, 2013) proposed analysis of installing a 50 MW solar photovoltaic power plant PV-grid connected with a tracking system in Libya. Solar PV modules of 200 W are used in that study due to its high conversion efficiency.

(Kassem et al., 2020) performed a study analysis of the potential and viability of generating electricity from a 10 MW solar plant grid-connected in Libya. The consequences of that study indicate that Libya has a massive potential of solar energy can be utilised to generate electricity.
