What is Mauritania's digital transformation project?

The project established an environment conducive to digital transformation in Mauritania by supporting the legal and regulatory framework, as well as the deployment of broadband infrastructure that is essential to the country's socioeconomic transformation, innovation, and job creation, particularly for women and youth.

Why did Mauritania deploy fiber optic cable?

The deployment of approximately 1,700 kilometers (km) of fiber optic cable enabled Mauritania to establish the necessary backbone for quality mobile Internet services. In addition, the strategic studies delivered by the project helped to promote competition, public-private partnerships (PPPs) and open access.

Who is financing Mauritania's warcip data center?
