

What is Morocco's solar export strategy?

Morocco's solar export strategy is a bold bid for geopolitical influence. By 2035, the country aims to develop 20 GW of solar capacity, with half earmarked for export, the Ministry of Energy projects. Therefore, this vision aligns with Europe's decarbonization goals, positioning Morocco as a linchpin in the transcontinental energy trade.

Does Morocco still have solar energy?

Morocco is known for its solar projects, but a lot of its energy is still sourced from fossil fuels (Source: US International Trade Administration, Credit: Pomona Pictures/BBC) Ultimately, Morocco missed its 2020 target, with enough renewable capacity to produce 37% of the country's energy in 2020.

Is Morocco a good place to invest in solar energy?

Beyond Midelt, Morocco aims to develop 10 gigawatts (GW) of renewable energy (20% from solar) by 2030, with solar energy constituting a significant share. The International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) notes that Morocco's solar potential, driven by 3,000 hours of annual sunshine, positions it as a prime location for large-scale projects.

Noor's success has laid the groundwork for Morocco's broader strategy, exporting solar energy to Europe. The complex demonstrates Morocco's ability to deliver large-scale renewable projects, earning the confidence of international partners.

What is Morocco's largest solar power plant?

Morocco also built the Noor-Ouarzazate complex, the world's largest concentrated solar power plant, an enormous array of curved mirrors spread over 3,000 hectares (11.6 sq miles) which concentrate the Sun's rays towards tubes of fluid, with the hot liquid then used to produce power.

How much energy does Morocco produce from renewables?

Production of energy from renewables lagged behind a little, at closer to 20% of the country's total in 2019. But the country has come a long way. Morocco has since pledged to increase the renewables in its electricity mix to 52% by 2030, made up of 20% solar, 20% wind and 12% hydro.
