Why are battery energy storage systems important in New Zealand?

Does New Zealand have a power system?

New Zealand's power system is undergoing a rapid transformation as the country's economy electrifies. While this creates opportunities, this also brings challenges for power system operation and for electricity reliability, including security of supply.

What is a battery energy storage system?

ESSs enable electrical energy to be stored and then injected into the power system when it is needed most. This ensures that homes and businesses are powered even when the sun does not shine or the wind is not blowing. Battery energy storage systems (BESSs) are the most common new form of ESSs in New Zealand.

Achieving the carbon zero target will require the addition of generation and storage into the New Zealand power system if current levels of security of supply are to be maintained.
