Why are battery energy storage systems important in New Zealand?

There is growth in renewable energy generation as New Zealand moves to a low carbon economy. But renewable energy like solar and wind are intermittent which means Battery Energy Storage Systems, which can be flicked on to supply power quickly, are important to manage winter peaks, and to make the national power grid resilient.

What is the largest power station in New Zealand?

Huntly Power Station is the largest thermal power station in New Zealand, with a generation capacity of 1,200MW, making it the country's single largest electricity generation site. According to Saft, the power station plays an important role in the country's electricity market.

Where is the largest solar power plant in New Zealand?

The construction of the Huntly BESS follows Genesis Energy's recent launch of what it claims is the country's largest solar PV power plant: the 63MWp Lauriston site, located west of Christchurch on the South Island, near the Rakaia River in the Canterbury Plains.
