How much does a commercial wind turbine cost?

How much do commercial wind turbines cost? A utility-scale wind turbine costs between \$1.3 million to \$2.2 million per MW of installed nameplate capacity. Most commercial-scale turbines installed nowadays are 2 MW in capacity and cost between \$3 and \$4 million to install.

How much does a wind turbine cost in 2024?

In 2024, the average capital cost for onshore turbines ranges between \$900 and \$1,200 per kilowatt (kW), while offshore turbines can cost between \$2,000 and \$3,000 per kW due to their complexity and installation challenges. Installation costs are influenced by site-specific conditions such as terrain, grid connection, and logistical considerations.
