

# North Macedonia wind solar and energy storage project construction

How many wind turbines are there in North Macedonia?

The Bogdanci wind park, North Macedonia's first wind energy facility, currently operates with sixteen wind turbines, each with a capacity of two to three megawatts. Plans to expand this wind park aim to further boost clean energy production in the country.

Does North Macedonia have a wind farm?

North Macedonia has a 36.8 MW wind farm at Bogdanci and has received EU and KfW financing to expand it. It was the first country in the Western Balkan region to put into operation a sizeable wind facility. Its second wind farm, the 36-MW Bogoslovec, was officially opened in mid-2024.

Is North Macedonia a sustainable country?

"The huge sustainable energy potential of North Macedonia, especially through wind and solar energy, is an enormous opportunity for the country, which is important in the advancement of the Green Agenda", emphasized Holger Schröder from the European Commission's Directorate for Neighbourhood Policy (DG NEAR).

Will Alcazar Energy Partners build the largest wind farm in North Macedonia?

SKOPJE, North Macedonia (AP) -- North Macedonia's government on Tuesday announced a \$500 million project with renewables investor Alcazar Energy Partners to build the largest wind farm in the landlocked country. Prime Minister Hristijan Mickoski said the project would significantly boost energy independence, as well as foreign investment.

Where is a wind farm located in the Western Balkans?

The wind farm, to be located in the country's southeast, will be one of the largest in the Western Balkans, with a capacity to generate up to 400 megawatts of renewable energy. Construction is expected to begin in early 2026.
