



Outdoor base station time calibration

How do I display the temperature on the base station?

Press the UP/C/F button at the back of the base station to display the temperature in °C or °F. Press CHANNEL to select the remote channel you want displayed permanently on the base station. Or keep pressing CHANNEL until you observe a circular arrow C on the base station LCD display under the channel number.

How do I reconnect my outdoor sensor to the base station?

There are steps below that will assist you in getting the sensor to reconnect with the base station and in most instances will rectify the issue without any further steps needed. 1. Bring the outdoor sensor in from outdoors and place it approximately 1-3 metres away from the base station.

How do I remove the outdoor sensor from the base station?

1. Bring the outdoor sensor in from outdoors and place it approximately 1-3 metres away from the base station.
2. Remove all batteries (this includes the outdoor sensor/sensors and the base station) and allow all items to completely drain for approximately 20 minutes.
