

Outdoor power attenuation rate

What is attenuation rate?

The utility of the attenuation rate concept is that it allows us to quickly calculate loss for any distance of wave travel: This loss is simply attenuation rate (dB/m) times length (m), which yields loss in dB. A particular coaxial cable has an attenuation constant $\alpha \cong 8.5 \times 10^{-3} \text{ m}^{-1}$.

What does attenuation mean?

It indicates the loss of electrical signal's strength due to several factors (type of cable, impedance of the cable, interference, noise, range or distance etc.). We can measure attenuation in decibels (dB) to accurately indicate the amount of power loss in the transmission line. Attenuation indicates loss of signal strength.

How do you calculate power attenuation?

Then the formula becomes: Power Attenuation AP (dB) = $10 \log_{10} |P_T / P_R|$ Power Attenuation AP (dB) = $10 \log_{10} |P_S / P_D|$ Apart from power, we can also use input and output voltages to express attenuation.

How does attenuation affect wireless signal quality?
